He continued his studies with Edith Fischer, the most important disciple of world acclaimed pianist Claudio Arrau, perpetuating the tradition of this great master.

He graduated from the Liceu Superior Music Conservatory (Barcelona, Spain), where he studied with Josep Maria Colom, one of the most exceptional pianists of our time in Spain.

Wrapped in a typical warm sound, the intense blend and organic musicality of his interpretation tend to a mystical touch, instilled by his spiritual immersion in the very heart of Zen philosophy.

Takao Rokugawa is regularly invited to perform in concerts and recitals around Japan and in European countries.
